

Arrangements are made with the Rectory. A Letter of Recommendation for the Godparent or each Godparent is required before scheduling a date. Attendance to a Baptismal preparation class is also required within the past 3 years at our Parish.

#### <u>LETTERS OF</u> <u>RECOMMENDATION</u> <u>For Parishioners:</u>

These are issued to members of our Parish who are registered and practice the faith through Mass attendance and receiving the Sacraments.

#### <u>For Sponsors not from</u> <u>Our Parish</u>:

They should be Baptized, Confirmed, and a practicing Catholic. Out of town college students should receive a letter from their Campus Minister. Military personnel should receive the letter from their Chaplain.

First Reading: Acts 10:34a, 37-43 In his speech, Peter places much emphasis on his personal witness to the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. To whom this week could you witness your faith in the resurrection of Jesus?

Second Reading: Col 3:1-4 or 1 Cor 5:6b-8 Paul taught the believers in Colossae to anticipate the return of the resurrected Jesus. How does your family celebrate Easter Sunday?

<u>Gospel</u>: Jn 20:1-9 or Mk 16:1-7 Mary Magdala, Peter, and the Beloved Disciple were the first to experience the joy and mystery of the empty tomb. Do you recall when you first started believing in the Resurrection of Jesus?
