

# Class Style Descriptions

## **TRADITIONAL**

Students will attend their weekly IN PERSON scheduled sessions in a traditional classroom setting.

# FAMILY SESSION

During these IN PERSON sessions, the students with their families will join and gather with other families and explore our faith.

## **COLLABORATIVE**

Students will attend IN PERSON sessions that include games/crafts, an appropriate discussion, reflection questions for small group sharing and a challenge for the coming week.

#### **EDGE**

IN PERSON interactive program that challenges young people to become disciples and change their world, ask about God, faith, the Church, and what it means to be a disciple.

# PARENT LED

Parents will help their student complete the provided lessons AT HOME including online videos, discussion questions, and quizzes at the end of each lesson. These lessons will be provided and reviewed by the FF Director.

## **HOME STUDY**

Families will engage in provided PARENT LED lessons. Families will also be required to attend the monthly FAMILY SESSION\*.

# HYBRID

Students will engage in a combination of PARENT LED lessons and age appropriate COLLABORATIVE classes.

## **GOD'S FAMILY**

A faith-filled community for families with persons with special physical, cognitive, or emotional needs. This program offers support for both parents and siblings.

Faith Formation classes are uniform throughout our Family of Parishes, including textbooks and material covered.

With our universal program, you are now able to choose from all the classes in our Family, rather than just one at your Parish.

This helps make it easier to find a class that fits your family's schedule from year to year and ensure that your child receives all the information without having to catch up or repeat anything!
